Students may come from any discipline across campus. The Designated Emphasis provides students with certification as well as with a context for the interdisciplinary exchange of ideas and development of research.

Applicants will be selected on the basis of their academic qualifications, the appropriateness of their interests to the program's teaching resources, and the enrollment capacity of the required courses. Admission to the GMS Designated Emphasis is determined by the Admissions Committee on a rolling basis throughout the academic year.

Qualified applicants must:

1. Be currently enrolled in a Ph.D. program and in good academic standing.
2. Apply at least two semesters before taking their Oral Qualifying Exam.
